Case Overview

- **Name:** John Doe
- **Age:** 58
- **Cause of Death:** Complications from chronic liver failure (cirrhosis)
- **Time Since Death:** ~18 hours
- **Body Condition:** Slight edema in lower extremities; pronounced jaundice (yellow discoloration of skin and sclera); no visible trauma
- **Weight:** 165 lbs
- **Postmortem Changes:** Early signs of desquamation on shoulders, mild dehydration in hands, no significant livor mortis fixation
